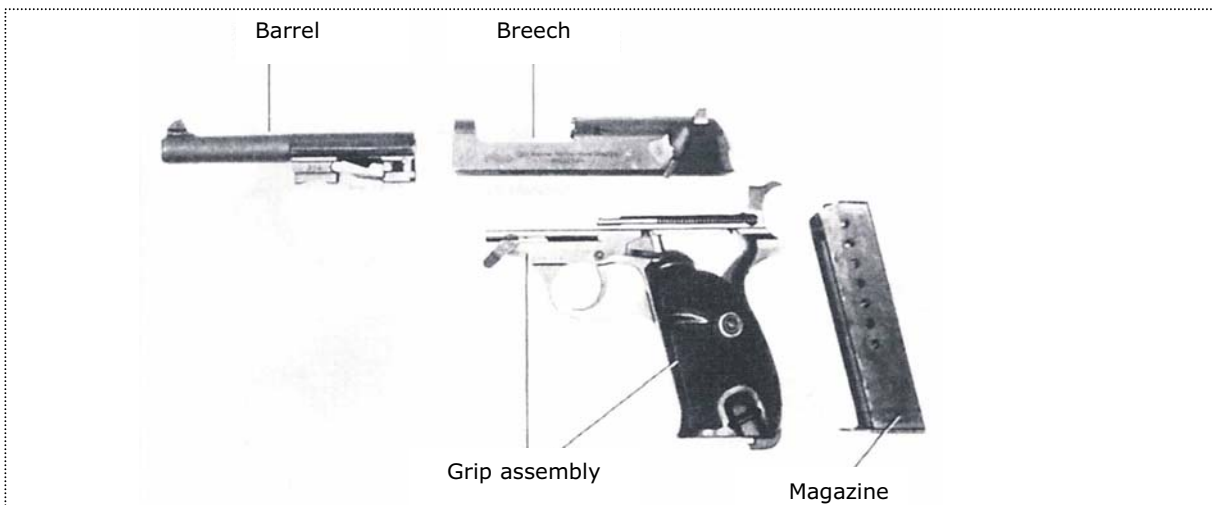
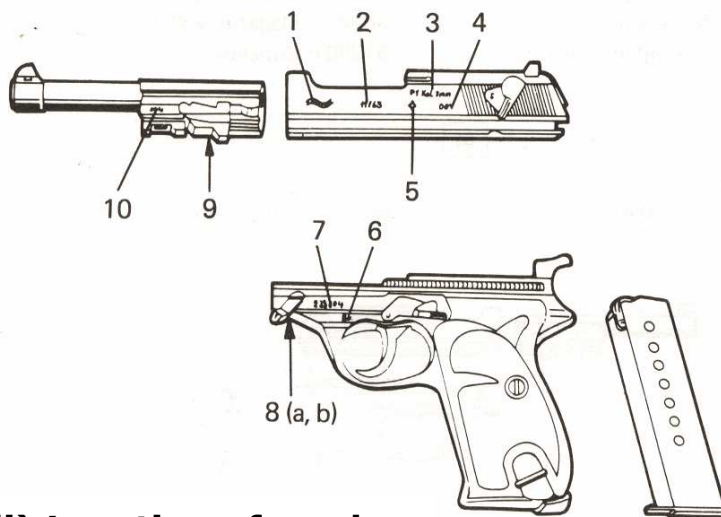


**Exhibit 1.1.1:B General assembly and location of marks**

**NOTE**

- For pistols of earlier manufacturing—
- mark no. 2 is on the reverse (*i.e.* right) side of the breech
  - mark no. 3 reads as follows: "P38 Cal. 9 mm"
  - no 4-point asterisk on the breech is used
